

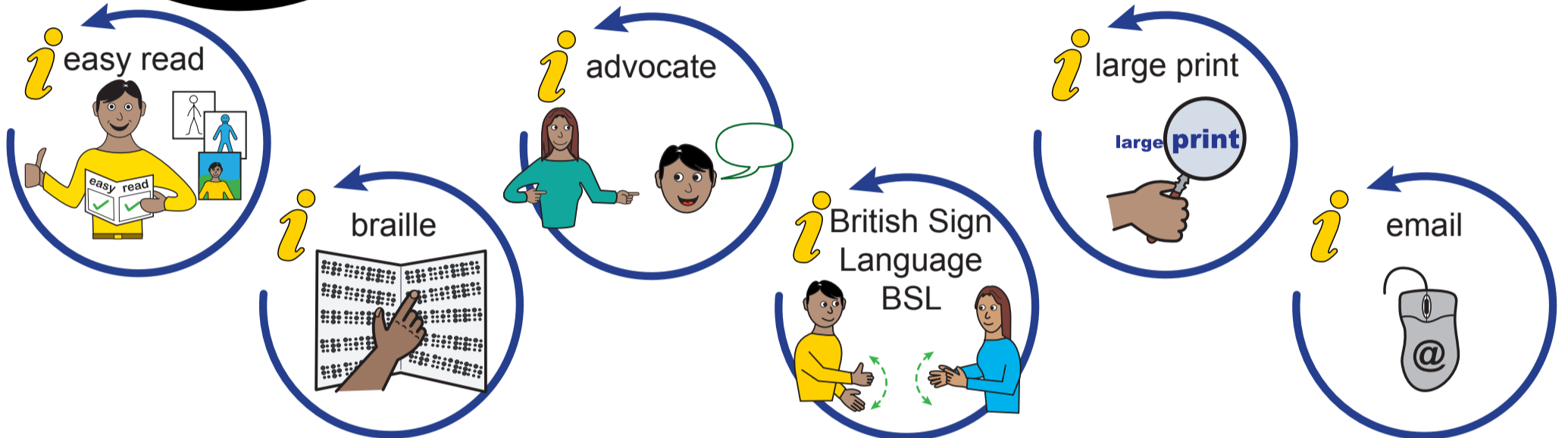
# The Accessible Information Standard started on 1st April 2016.



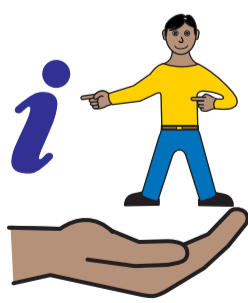
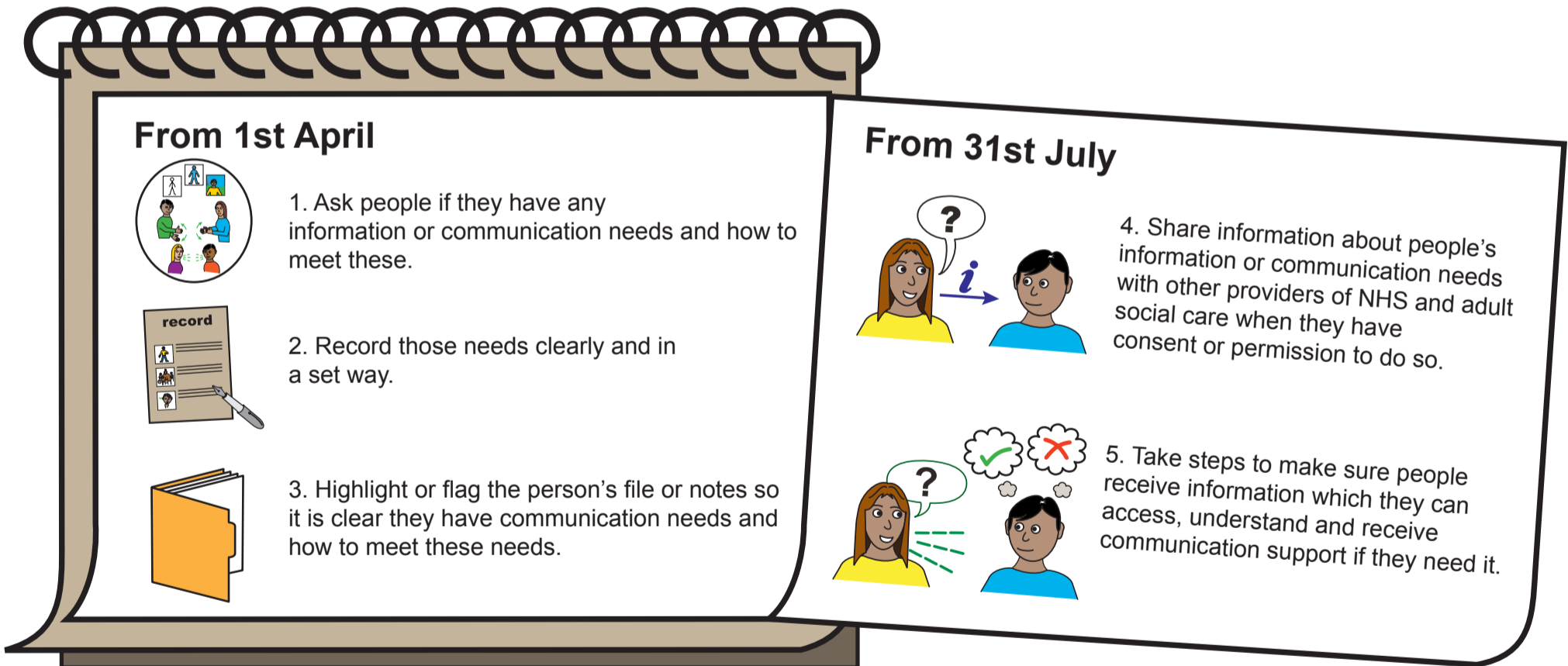
**This applies to all NHS and adult social care organisations.**
